



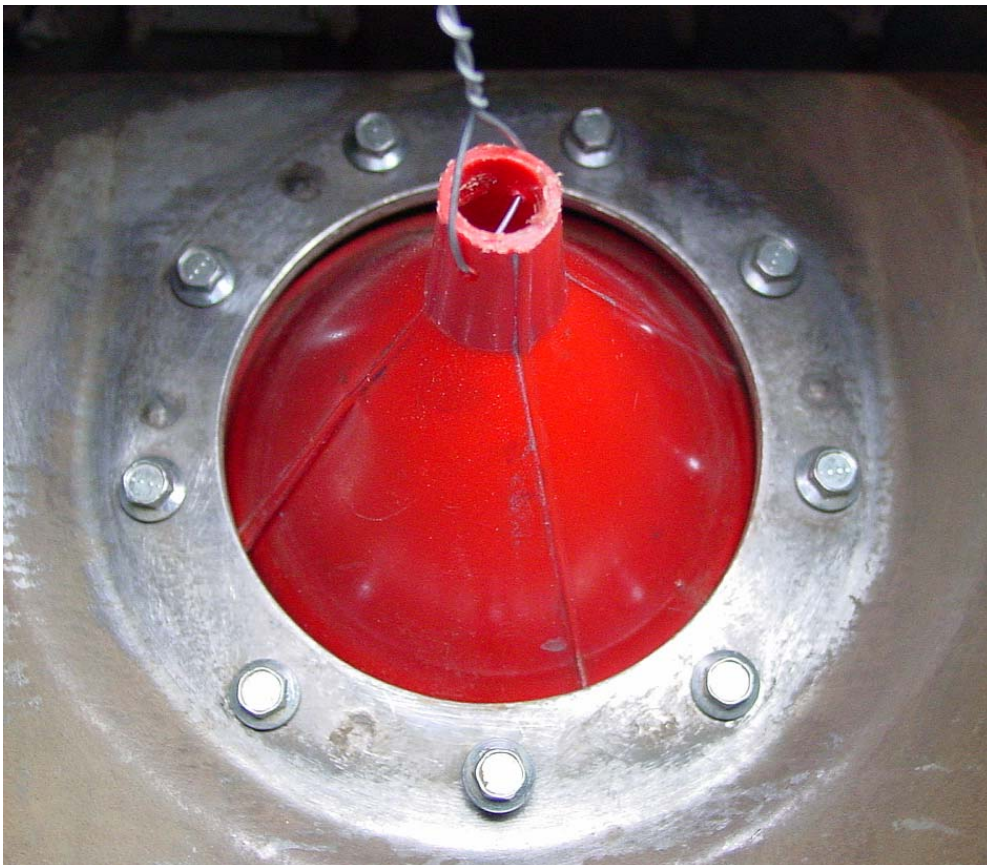
Fuel filler neck for a mid-year coupe.

(Longer than the one for roadsters)

Mounts to the tank with 9 small screws that have a rubber washer on them.

A thin cork gasket is all that seals the neck to the tank.

This is a frequently reported area for fuel leaks. Not a problem if you don't fill the tank up to the neck.



I cut a slit in a funnel so that I could insert it to keep debris out of the tank while I cleaned the area around the neck.
